what is hynt?

Hynt is a new national access scheme that works with theatres and arts centres in Wales to make sure there is a consistent offer available for visitors with an impairment or specific access requirement, and their Carers or Personal Assistants. This site will tell you all you need to know about Hynt: who it's for; what it provides; and how to become a member.

If you need support or assistance to attend a performance at a theatre or arts centre then you may be eligible to join hynt.

Demonstrate the confidence and skills to use appropriate etiquette in guiding blind and partially sighted (BPS) people


Identify methods by which visual art can be made more inclusive using audio description, recorded descriptions and tours, one to one or in groups


Use appropriate approaches to describe images and objects to BPS people

Research, script and deliver an Audio Described Tour with appropriate handling opportunities






Vanishing Point – Kelly Best









- Develop meaningful and sustainable provision and respond to (potential and existing) audiences effectively
- Consider wayfinding within the Gallery as a whole (particularly as we head to a capital project)
- Consider and action the implications upon resources working strategically to develop and present AD and wider access more generally. Particularly when considering fast pace programme of temporary exhibitions and requirements of bi-lingualism.
- Accommodating provision within wider activity of public programmes and offer to schools
- Research hardware and approach (varying audience needs / preferences) PENs require outsourcing for each new file made with the appropriate trigger (badge or swell paper) made also. They are not intuitive and have to be requested and activated for each file.
- Looking more creatively at content; different voices, sounds etc
- Ease of use and seamless integration in experience
